3. Approval of Agenda:

9. Recommendations from Committee Of The Whole:

10. Outside Committee Appointment Reports:

Solid Waste:

- Council asked about single use plastics. Councillor Malloy explained that there will be presentations prepared and either presented to Council or given to Council in written form.

11. CAO Report:

EMO Committee:

- Council asked if there has been another EMO meeting. The CAO stated there was a meeting on September 23rd and another set for October 30th, 2019.
- Councillor Kaiser-Kirk expressed a question from a member of the volunteer fire department in Port Bickerton regarding reimbursement from expenses incurred from the recent hurricane. The CAO said he will check with EMO officer to see if volunteer fire departments can seek provincial reimbursement.

Before and After Care Program:

- Council asked how the program was going. The CAO informed them that the morning portion of the program has had no attendance and the afternoon attendance has had around 7 or 8 participants.

Pioneer Park:

- Council asked how the public meeting went that was held September 26th, 2019. Councillor Smith stated she had gone and it was well attended with positive conversation. At this point it is in the information stage with a further meeting to discuss structure on October 17th, 2019.

Finance:

- Council asked about the figure for outstanding taxes collected for the 2019/2020. The Director of Finance stated that this amount was a reflection of the taxes collected to date, as of September 30th, 2019 for all outstanding years.

Fences Arbitration Committee:

- Council asked if there were any updates from the meeting held September 3rd, 2019. The CAO stated that a letter was sent to the Minister of Agriculture to ask to be designated as a municipality for the purposes of the Fences and Detention of Stray Livestock Act. No further correspondence has been received.
