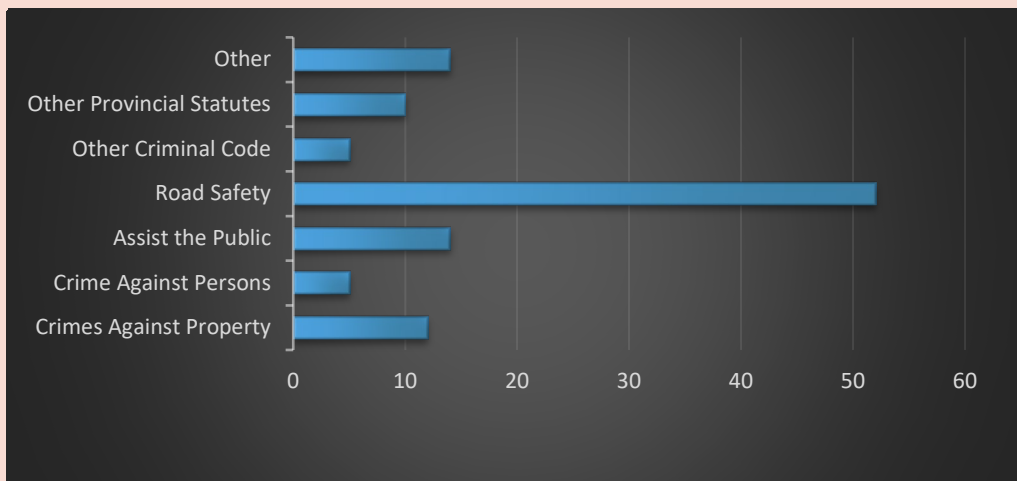

Guysborough District RCMP have arrested and charged an Antigonish man for break and enter to the Seven Communities Fire Hall in Hadleyville that occurred on October 12th, 2025. Brent Chisholm, 27, was released on a condition for a curfew from 10:00 PM – 7:00 AM each day and to appear in Antigonish Provincial Court on January 28th to enter a plea.

Crime Prevention

As colder weather approaches, the RCMP is urging residents to take precautions against seasonal property crime, which tends to increase when properties are less occupied.

“Property crime is often a crime of opportunity,” an RCMP spokesperson said. “During the off-season, there are fewer people around, making seasonal properties and equipment more vulnerable.”

RCMP advise residents to:

- Store off-road vehicles in locked garages, sheds, or storage units, drain fuel, and block vehicles with barriers.
- Secure farm equipment in locked buildings, use wheel clamps or remove batteries, keep keys safe, and maintain records of serial numbers and descriptions. Mark equipment with security identifiers such as postal codes.
- Remove valuables from seasonal properties, including tools and electronics, and post signs indicating nothing of value is left on site.
- Store outdoor furniture and ensure all doors, windows, gates, and outbuildings are secured.
- Properly secure firearms and other hunting equipment.
- Consider installing security cameras, motion-activated lights, or GPS trackers for high-value equipment.



Road Safety

Guysborough District members have been spending time in Larry's River due to high speeds reported in the area. Cst. Nudo noticed that there were a few high bushes in front of the 60 km/hr sign in the community. Although it wasn't enough to block the sign, Cst. Nudo didn't want any excuses as to why people were speeding and making the roadway unsafe for themselves and others.



A local driver was charged with driving a motor vehicle while their license was suspended on November 10th near Hazel Hill. The driver was given a summons to appear in Antigonish Provincial Court on January 9, 2026, to enter a plea to the charge.

Another driver was charged on November 30th for driving while their license was revoked and will appear in Antigonish Provincial Court on January 30th, 2026.

What is a suspended drivers license?

A suspended license is a temporary measure that prevents the holder from driving for a specified period due to a violation of traffic laws or accumulating points on their license. A suspension is temporary & can be lifted after a period of time and compliance with certain conditions.

What is a revoked license?

A revoked license is a permanent loss of driving privileges, often reserved for more serious offences such as repeat DUI's or causing a serious collision. Revoked licenses require a thorough assessment of the driver's skills and may involve additional testing and rehabilitation programs before the license can be restored.

Guysborough District RCMP members set up five check stops during the month in the communities of Fox Island, Guysborough, Ecum Secum, Goldenville, and Eastside Harbour Road.

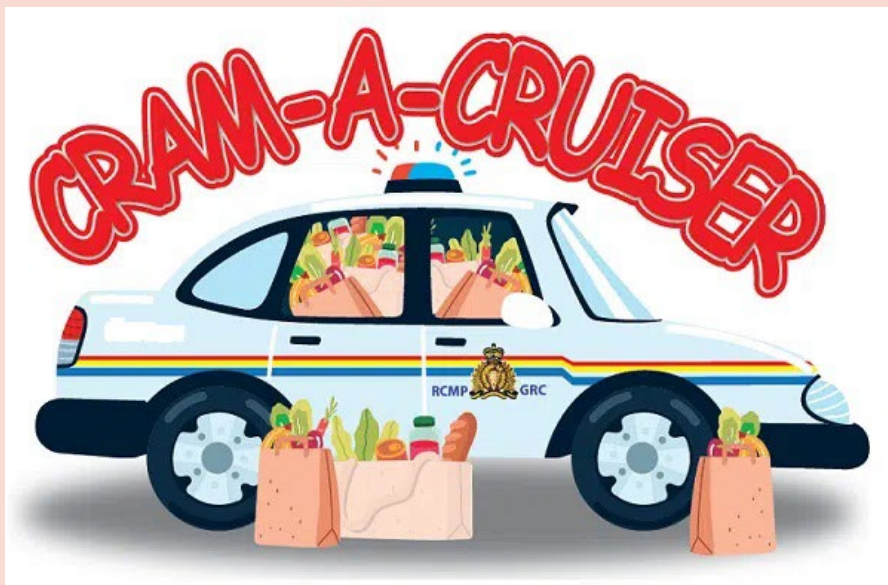


Cst. Nudo also took part in the career fair at the school in Guysborough. He and EHS paramedic, Johanna, met with students interested in a career in emergency response.
