

Invitation to Tender

STP Upgrades

Sealed tenders plainly marked "Municipality of the District of St. Mary's – STP Upgrades" will be received at 298 Reeves Street, Unit 9, Port Hawkesbury, Nova Scotia, B9A 2B4, Phone (O) 902-625-3631 until **2:00pm on October 15, 2020**. There will be a site meeting **Wednesday, October 7, 2020 at 10am**.

The work under this project shall generally comprise but not necessarily be limited to provision of all labour, materials, and equipment for the erection of a new UV treatment building (2.8m X 4.8m), installation of Owner supplied UV equipment, mechanical, electrical yard grading and connection to existing outfall piping. Also included is the installation of a new Owner supplied aeration system in the existing equalization tank, and the sandblasting and painting of an existing EQ tank, two Aeration Tanks, and sludge holding tank, located at the St. Mary's Sewage Treatment Plant in Sherbrooke, Nova Scotia.

Cheques can be made payable to Strait Engineering Limited.

Tenders by Contractors must be accompanied by a certified cheque or bid bond for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount of the tendered price. The bid bond shall be in the standard bid bond form of an approved surety and shall be accompanied by an agreement to bond to provide that surety will issue good and sufficient performance and Labour and Materials bonds, each in the value of fifty percent (50%) of the contract amount.

The lowest or any Tender may not be accepted. Such things as reliability, relative experience, start/completion dates, and availability of equipment and work force will all be taken into consideration when awarding the Tender.

The right is reserved to reject any or all Tenders or to accept any Tender that may be considered in the best interest of the Municipality of the District of St. Mary's.
