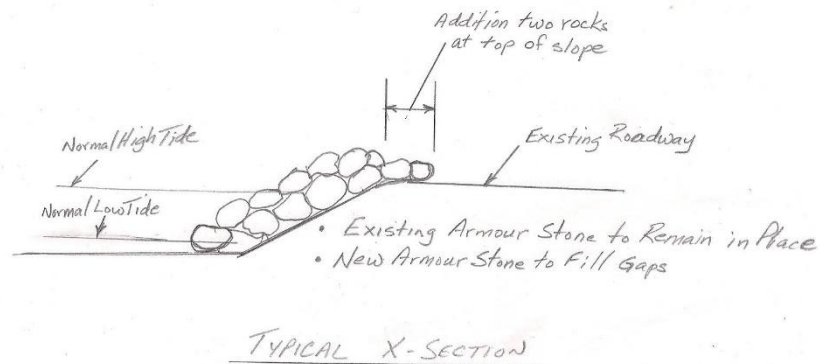

SCOPE OF WORK/ SPECIFICATIONS:

The work consists of the furnishing of all materials, labour and equipment for the gravel upgrading of the existing roadway and to place protective armour stone along an approximately 500 foot section of the roadway at the location as identified by the Municipality and marked by survey stakes at the site.

The work will include but, not necessarily be limited to, reshaping the roadway to restore the original width of the roadway, ditching on the north side of a section of roadway, installing an 18" PVC corrugated culvert, and placing of armour stones along approximately 500' of shore line.

The armour stone is to be a minimum of 2' in size and is to be supplied by the contractor. The existing stones on site are to remain in place and additional armour stone is to be placed on the slope to fill gaps and complete two layers of armour stone protection to the shoreline. Two stone are to be placed at the top of the slope for additional protection to the roadway surface. Sketch below shows the typical cross-section for the armour stone protection portion of this project.

Bidders are instructed to visit the site to become familiar with the potential conditions under which the contract may have to be completed. Site visits are also recommended to review and verify the form, nature, and extent of work, materials needed, the access to the site, severity, exposure, and uncertainty of weather, soil conditions and to obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which should be covered in their bid price.

2. BID

Please BID your **net** price exclusive of taxes on the “Form of Tender” enclosed in this package.

3. PAYMENT

Payment shall be based on Net 30 Days from date of invoice following completion of the work.

4. TAXES

The BID price shall be HST extra.

5. WORKSAFE NS

The successful bidder must provide proof of current coverage from the Nova Scotia Workers' Compensation Board

The Contractor must meet all Provincial Safety standards and Labour Regulations. The contractor shall provide to the municipality their Worksafe registration number and a letter of Clearance from the Worksafe office prior to commencement of work. The contractor shall ensure compliance on his part with the Workers Compensation Act and any regulations there under.

6. DUE DILIGENCE:

If the contractor is found to be working in an unsafe manner, or outside of current legislation, they will be made to stop work immediately.

Any losses which may arise as a result of this work stoppage are the responsibility of the contractor. Failure to comply with current legislation on the part of the contractor, may lead to cancellation of contract.

7. INSURANCE

The successful contractor shall provide evidence of commercial liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$2 million.

8. EXPLANATION TO BIDDERS

No verbal agreement or conversation with any officer, agent or employee of the owner either before or after execution of the contract shall affect or modify any of the terms or obligations contained in any of the documents comprising the said contract.

9. TIME LIMITS

Bids received after the time and date as shown on the request for quotation shall not be considered and will be returned unopened to the bidder.

10. ACCEPTANCES, REVOCATION AND REJECTION OF TENDERS

The Municipality of St. Mary's does not bind itself to accepting the lowest or any tender received, but reserves the right to award the tender to its best advantage.

12. REQUIREMENTS FOR FINAL INSPECTION

All items must be completed prior to final inspection. No exceptions will be made, and final payment will be delayed until all items are complete.

13. INDEMNIFICATION

The contractor agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Municipality of the District of St. Mary's from and against all claims, actions, losses, expense, costs or damages of every nature and kind whatsoever which may occur through the performance of this contract.
