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Addendum No.1

RFP – Old Road Hill Multi-Use Trail Design

To all potential proponents,

This Addendum is issued to provide clarification and additional information related to the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Old Road Hill Multi-Use Trail Design. This Addendum forms part of the RFP documents and shall be read in conjunction with them.

1. Professional Liability Insurance

Proponents are advised that the successful consultant will be required to carry professional liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$5,000,000 for the duration of the project.

2. Trail Length

The trail length described in the RFP is approximate. It is the responsibility of the consultant to determine the exact trail length as part of the design process.

The trail must connect the following two points:

- St. Mary's Recplex, located at 164 Old Road Hill, and Highway 7.

3. Public Consultation

The method(s) of public consultation are to be determined by the consultant. Public consultation is expected to occur during the preliminary conceptual design phase of the project.

4. Meetings

Where feasible and subject to scheduling availability, multiple meetings may be arranged on the same day.

5. Lighting Design

Proponents are to follow general pedestrian lighting requirements. A custom lighting design is not required but may be proposed if deemed appropriate by the consultant.

The Municipality has previously used the Sherbrooke Streetscapes Lighting Design as a reference.

6. Crosswalk Lighting

It is the responsibility of the consultant to determine whether lighting for crosswalks should be included within the scope of the design, based on best practices and project requirements.

7. Issued for Construction Drawings

Issued for Construction (IFC) drawings and specifications are required and shall be included as part of the project deliverables.

All other terms and conditions of the RFP remain unchanged.
